Have a look if your sport is on the program and don't forget to share with your friends and family for a big celebration at Europe's greatest Masters sports festival!

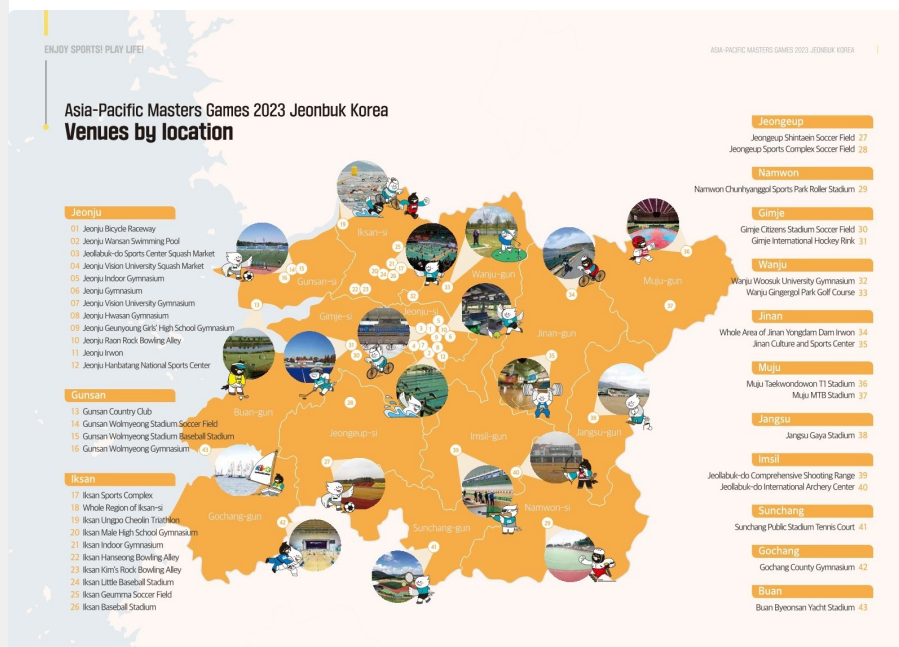

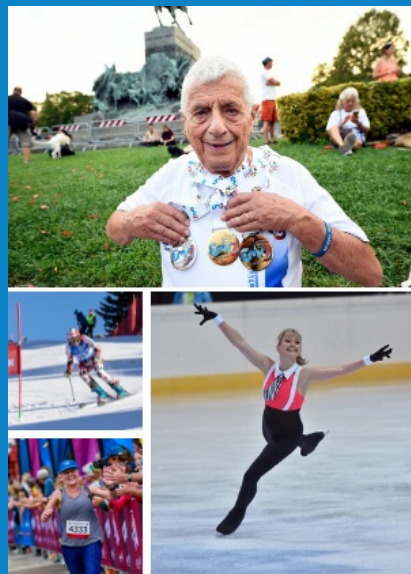
We want to hear your stories in 2022
